Located in Adelaide's historic original treasury building in the city's heart - opposite the GPO on King William Street - The Treasury offers several intimate function and dining spaces ideal for breakfast, lunch and evening occasions. The contemporary interior décor provides a stylish corporate environment for meetings and catered events for small groups.

The Treasury Bar

The Treasury bar boasts an innovative blend of chic fused with elegant simplicity. The bar has a savvy, sexy appeal with deep rich claret colour & modern light fittings. The room is dark & moody, perfect for that wind down drink after a long lunch or a hard day at the office.

The cleverly designed layout incorporates dining surrounds, a striking wine/cocktail bar & a luxurious lounge setting. There is also seating available in the beautiful courtyard and the King William street frontage.

On a Friday after office hours, this space & the bar vibrate with festive energy & fills fast with workers celebrating the week's end.

The wine list is carefully constructed with a distinct element of panache & offering a superb selection of classic varieties & regional matches chosen from Australia's premier grape growing regions as well as showcasing a select range of first class vintage wines for special occasions.

The cocktail list offers a variety of contemporary & classic drinks to cater to even the most fickle tastes. From Americano's to Zombie's, sweet to sour, there is something here for everyone.

Open from 12 noon Monday to Friday, the Treasury Bar menu has tasty lunch options such as pizza, pasta, soup, salads & braises as well as tapas style shared plates. Monday to Saturday evenings snacks are available and platters of finger food can be organized if requested in advance - the kitchen is open from 5.30pm - 9.30pm on these evenings.

The Treasury Courtyard

During regular opening hours the outside courtyard is available for casual groups of drinkers and those wishing to dine. Both the bar and the restaurant menus are available. The maximum number of diners that can be accommodated with the restaurant menu in one group outside is 20 (groups of between 20 and 60 can be accommodated inside).

The Treasury courtyard may be used for wedding ceremonies. However, as the apartments are accessed via the central courtyard and the bar may be open to the public, the courtyard is not necessarily available exclusively.

Due to the proximity of the accommodation, the CD music used in the courtyard is played at a moderate volume only and the courtyard needs to be vacated at 11.00pm at night. Should you wish to have an evening event in the courtyard; guests need to have been relocated inside to the bar by this time.

The Treasury Restaurant

This sophisticated nosherly is located within the award-winning Adina Apartment Hotel. This stately, heritage-listed establishment has graced the city's central street since the 19th century, but its historic facade gives way to a comparatively modern interior.

A finalist every year in the South Australian Restaurant & Catering Awards since 2003 and Winner of the Restaurant & Caterings Best Bistro award in 2004, 2008 & 2009, Best Restaurant in a pub/club/tavern in 2011& Best Restaurant in a Hotel in 2014.

The restaurant is light & airy befitting its expectation of a busy lunch or dinner trade. It boasts Italian designer furniture, a fireplace, subtle lighting and bare wooden tables softened by padded chairs. Banquette seating in the front window takes in city views, while the rear of the room looks out over a gorgeous courtyard with a lush lawn and an elegant fountain.

Head chef Doug Pike brings a wealth of experience & his team have created an award winning dining experience situated in & around one of Adelaide's most beautiful & historic buildings. The highly awarded menu delivers an eclectic array of dishes designed to delight the fussiest of diners. Appreciate premium grade steaks, tender game dishes & succulent seafoods; savour fresh flavours, diverse textures & zesty ingredients carefully composed to tempt & tantalise.

The Treasury wine list has a strong Australian focus with around a dozen wines available by the glass. The list offers a selection of vintage riesling, premium chardonnays and pinot noir and comprises a great range of current and back vintage Australian red wines.

The restaurant is open 7 days a week for breakfast, with lunch Monday to Friday and dinner Monday to Saturday.

The King William Room

Sited at ground level amid the street scape of Adelaide's central thoroughfare, The King William Room is suitable for groups of 8 to 12 guests. The natural light and landmark city views create a vibrant meeting space that brings the city to you.

A room hire fee applies.

The Alcove

With windows to King William Street and banquet seating, The Alcove is a semi-enclosed dining and meeting space for 4 to 6 persons. Ideal for breakfast meetings and business lunches and dinners, this intimate room is an ideal inner-city space for mixing business with fine dining. In addition, The Alcove may be requested for small social gatherings and romantic dinners.

The current A la Carte restaurant breakfast, lunch & dinner menus are offered with set menus available on request.

The Coffee Shop

Coffee & teas are available all day and can be enjoyed in the courtyard, restaurant or bar. Please place orders inside the restaurant from 7am til midday, and from inside the bar from midday until late.

Coffees & teas are not available for room service.

Functions at the Treasury

The Treasury Courtyard is ideal for cocktail parties both small and large. A selection of hot and cold food items is on offer with menus starting at around \$20 per person. For groups of 20 to 80 guests a portion of the courtyard is allocated and cordoned off. The entire courtyard is utilised for groups up to 140 people, though the availability is often limited.

The courtyard is not available for cocktail parties on Friday evenings.

To book the restaurant at The Treasury exclusively for a function group, generally a minimum of 45 people is required. This may be a smaller number depending on the service period - for example, on a Tuesday evening, we may book out the restaurant with only 40 guests. The restaurant's maximum capacity is 64 diners. Menus are created by selecting dishes from the current A la Carte menu.

The Treasury Bar can be booked exclusively for late night functions and post wedding reception drinks. A maximum of 50 people are permitted at any one time.

Room hire fees apply for use of function areas.

Cocktail Functions

At the Treasury on King William there are two spaces suitable for cocktail-style functions. The availability of these areas is limited due to licensing considerations – these spaces are not available on Friday afternoons and evenings, and at other times may depend on restaurant bookings and entertainment scheduling. Sunday bookings may incur an opening/room hire fee.

The Courtyard provides a combination of seats and standing area for up to 140 guests. The interior veranda offers a small area undercover although most of the courtyard is unsheltered. Most cocktail functions utilise a portion of the courtyard cordoned off – this is suitable for groups of 30 -80 guests.

The Treasury Bar can cater for a maximum of 50 guests with seating available for around 30 people – available exclusively only during non-public hours (i.e. Sundays).

Due to the difficulty of ordering some foods in small quantities, and the time consuming nature of food preparation for cocktail parties, the below menus are available for groups that number 30 at a minimum. For smaller groups, it may be possible to negotiate a mixture of cocktail-style foods from items on the bar menu and utilising ingredients we have on hand.

Terms and Conditions

Confirmation & deposit: a deposit of \$10 per person is required to confirm a booking and must be made within 7 Days of the original tentative booking. Payment of a deposit AND completion of a booking form must accompany this confirmation. The deposit will be deducted from your final account. Management reserves the right to cancel the booking and allocate the venue to another client if this confirmation is not received.

Payment & Final Numbers: are required 5 working days prior to the event. This number will represent the minimum numbers for which you will be charged. Final Accounts must be settled on or before the night, Payment on the night is accepted with cash or credit card only. Personal cheques are not accepted. Function payment may not be charged back to the hotel. Amex & Diners Club attract a 2.5% surcharge.

Cancellations: in case of a cancellation, the Treasury on King William will refund the deposit if the cancellation is made a minimum of 14 days prior to the function date.

Price: Please note that prices and products are subject to availability and change and may alter with notification. However they are firm from payment of a deposit for 2 months.

Menu: Details must be finalised at least 7 days prior to the function so our chefs can assure the quality and availability of food

Compliance: it is understood that the organiser will conduct the function in an orderly manner in full compliance with the Treasury on King William regulations and Liquor Licensing Laws. The Management reserves the right to exclude or eject any objectionable persons from the premises without liability.

Responsible service of alcohol: the Treasury on King William practices responsible service of alcohol on all occasions. Intoxicated persons will not be served alcohol.

Responsibility: Organisers are financially responsible for any damage/ breakages sustained to the Treasury on King William by the organiser, organisers guests, invitees or other persons attending the function. The Treasury on King William will not accept any responsibility for the damage or loss of merchandise left prior to or after the function.

Displays of signage: Nothing is to be nailed, screwed or adhered to any surface or part of the building.

BYO cakes: We are happy for you to provide a cake for your function. A \$4.50 cake cutting fee per person will apply. No other food or beverage is to be brought in and consumed in the function.

Courtyard Bookings and Weather: All courtyard bookings are made at the organisers risk. In case of poor weather, Management will attempt to relocate courtyard bookings subject to availability. The Treasury on King William is bound by Liquor Licensing Laws which may prevent such a relocation. The Treasury on King William reserves the right to cancel
